Tuesday	Reading packet Water bottle	read with your child each day or as regularly as possible. Spellings will be set on Monday
Wednesday	Reading packet Water bottle	and our spelling test takes place on Friday.
Thursday	Reading packet Water bottle	Maths homework will be set on Friday (starting 13.9.24) and should be sent in via eSchools by the following Wednesday
Friday	Reading packet Water bottle Home spelling book (so we can record your child's score. We will send these home with new spellings in each Monday)	please. Topic homework for the half- term will be set from 13.9.24, and can be sent in anytime via eSchools.

A Love of Reading

We will be reading a lot of fantastic books as part of our English lessons and these will be added to our eSchools page as we read them. We will also be rewarding reading at home with small prizes to work towards.
